STUDENT RESOURCES SCHEME

The Student Resource Scheme has been implemented at Yeronga State School to ensure that all students have the necessary resources to support their educational requirements. It is also intended as a convenience to parents/caregivers to provide a more economical option to purchasing resources and consumables each year.

Contribution to the scheme is voluntary. Parents/caregivers are under no obligation to join, however they will need to purchase and provide all necessary textbooks and resources for the students if they elect not to join the scheme.

The Student Resource Scheme operates at this school under the policy and guidelines of the Department of Education and Training (DET). The Yeronga State School P&C supports and authorises the Student Resource Scheme. Parents wishing to take advantage of the resources and services provided by the scheme pay an annual flat fee. Students in Year 3 – 6 will also need to provide additional items as noted.

BENEFITS OF PARTICIPATING IN THE SCHEME

Prep – Year 2

Students participating in the Student Resource Scheme will have all items provided.

Year 3 - 6

Students participating in the Student Resource Scheme will have all textbooks, workbooks, art supplies and folders provided.

* Year 3 students will need to provide their own pencil case containing writing pencils, erasers, ruler, scissors and sharpener, as well as a recorder.

** Year 4 & 5 Students will need to provide their own pencil case containing writing pencils, erasers, ruler, scissors and sharpener.

*** Year 6 students will need to provide their own pencil case containing writing pencils, erasers, ruler, scissors and sharpener, as well as red and blue pens.

NON-PAYMENT OF FEES

The school operates the Student Resource Scheme to benefit all eligible students. It is not viable for the school to provide this service if fees are outstanding. It is for this reason that students may be refused entry into the scheme if fees are outstanding from the previous year/s.

PRO RATA REFUNDS

Students leaving school will be entitled, after receipt of a written request, to a pro-rata refund of any Student Resource Scheme fees paid to the school. The pro rata calculation is based on a 40 week school year. A refund will be issued within one month of the school being notified that student has left.

ACTION REQUIRED

- Read the Student Resource Scheme Participation Agreement Form
- Complete the Student Resource Scheme Participation Link – a separate form must be completed for each student before Wednesday 31 October 2018
- Strictly no late orders will be accepted
- An invoice will be sent to participating families in November
- Payment can be made via BPoint or QParents
- Families that choose not to participate in the Student Resource Scheme will need to download the book list from the school website and provide all items at the start of school year.
